We hereby inform users, pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation 679/2016, of the processing of personal data carried out through this website.

The processing of personal data is carried out in compliance with current legislation on the protection of personal data and is based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and data protection.

We would like to point out that this information refers exclusively to the data of those who interact with the services accessible from the home page <https://www.humanitasedu.it/> (the site), without extending to other websites that may be reached by the user through the links on the site.

In the web pages, where data is collected following the request for a service, specific information is made available and, where necessary, the relative consent is obtained.

Contact Data of the Owner

The owner, for the collection of personal data of users who use the services of this site, is Humanitas Mirasole S.p.A, p. iva 10125410158, in the person of its legal representative pro tempore, with registered office in Rozzano (MI), via Manzoni, 56.

Type of Data Processed

- Navigation Data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users who connect to the site, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and computer environment.

This information is not collected to be associated with identified parties, as the data are used only to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its proper functioning, but by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, to identify users.

It should be noted that competent authorities could use the data to ascertain responsibility in the event of hypothetical computer crimes.

- Cookies

- Data provided voluntarily by the user

To access certain services reserved for users, you must register and enter certain personal data.

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The provision of certain identification data is necessary in order to authenticate and verify the legitimacy of access, in the different levels of the reserved areas, to the subjects who access them.

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of electronic mail to the addresses indicated on this site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.

Purpose

The processing that we intend to carry out, with your specific consent where necessary, has the following purposes:

- 1) To allow the provision of the Services requested by you also in the reserved area of the Site, including the booking of examinations and medical examinations and payment;
- 2) To comply with any legal, accounting and tax obligations;
- 3) For any defensive activity that may be necessary for the Data Controller;
- 4) Optimize the commercial offer also through focused and selected analyses;
- 5) To send advertising and/or commercial proposals based on the profiling of your data, implemented in order to highlight information and commercial proposals in tune with the interests that you have expressed by accessing the pages and using the services available on this site.

Legal basis

The processing of your personal data will be carried out on the basis of one or more of the following conditions. In particular, the processing operations carried out for the purposes described above, which concern:

- Point 1, have as legal basis the need to implement your express requests to receive a service directly available through the site: therefore the provision of data is strictly necessary and related to a pre-contractual phase and/or contractual or functional to respond to a specific request, as such the data collected from time to time are necessary and, if you do not intend to provide them, we cannot provide the service or give an answer to what you requested;
- Point 2, 3, will have as legal basis the need to comply with a legal obligation such as the obligation to implement security measures provided by laws and regulations in the field of health/hospital for certain services provided through the site and how such data and its processing are required;
- Points 4, 5, will have as legal basis your consent, which will be required in special pages of the site and preceded by our specific information or through cookies (see section dedicated to the cookie policy). In this case, the provision of data is absolutely free, and in the absence of your consent the data will not be collected and used in any way for these purposes. Furthermore, it is possible to revoke the given consent at any time,

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without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing already carried out according to the methods indicated in the following paragraphs.

Without prejudice to the above, in the web pages, an information notice is made available from time to time, which contains, among other things, the legal basis of the processing related to the service requested.

Processing methods, security measures and storage times

All data will be processed mainly in electronic format. Personal data and any other information directly or indirectly associated with a specific user, are collected and processed by applying technical and organizational security measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk, taking into account the state of the art and the costs of implementation and, where provided, security measures prescribed by specific legislation, such as, by way of example and not limited to, measures issued by the Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data or by specific rules and regulations for the health sector/hospital.

The processed personal data will be kept in a form that allows the identification of those concerned for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed, without prejudice to the need to keep them for a longer period, by law, following requests from the competent authorities on the prevention and prosecution of crimes or, however, to assert or defend a right in court.

Categories of recipients of personal data

Personal data will be processed by personnel specifically authorized by the owner as well as by any third party service providers, who will operate as data processors, only when this is necessary for the needs of operation and maintenance of the site and services made available through the site itself, Except for the cases considered above, your personal data will not be disclosed and/or communicated to third parties, except where required by law.

Rights of the interested party and contact details of the DPO
