

## PRIVACY NOTICE

This notice is provided pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016—the General Data Protection Regulation—regarding the processing of your personal data.

In accordance with the aforementioned regulation, such processing will be based on the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, and the protection of confidentiality.

We therefore provide the following information:

### 1. IDENTITY AND CONTACT DETAILS OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

Humanitas University, with registered office in Pieve Emanuele (MI), Via Rita Levi Montalcini 4; Humanitas Mirasole S.p.A., with registered office in Rozzano (MI) - Via Manzoni 56, Cliniche Gavazzeni S.p.A., Via Mauro Gavazzeni 21, Humanitas Istituto Clinico Catanese, with registered office in Misterbianco (CT), Contrada Cubba Marletta, 11, each in the person of its pro tempore legal representative, are “Joint Controllers” of the processing of your personal data for the purposes described. The processing, pursuant to Article 26 of EU Regulation 2016/679, is carried out in the management of the Humanitas Group’s educational and conference activities.

### 3. CATEGORIES OF DATA, PURPOSES, AND LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

The processing of your personal data (personal and contact information, information about your professional role, and, in the case of purchases, also data necessary for billing) is carried out for the following purposes:

- a) to register and create your profile on the Humanitas Edu platform;
- b) to carry out internal administrative activities for the provision of educational activities and conference that you have decided to participate in;
- c) sending, via email or other channels, informational material regarding activities/services, events, and initiatives promoted by Humanitas EDU;

The processing of your personal data for the purposes referred to in points a) and b) does not require consent, as it is necessary for the performance of the requested service and is lawful pursuant to Article 6(b) of EU Regulation 679/2016. The processing of personal data for the purpose referred to in point c) is subject to your specific consent and is therefore lawful pursuant to Article 6(a) of EU Regulation 679/2016.

In any case, you may revoke your consent and object to receiving further communications by using the “unsubscribe” option at the bottom of email communications and newsletters.

### 4. RECIPIENTS AND SCOPES OF DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA

Data processing will be carried out using IT tools by appropriately authorized employees of the Data Controllers or by service providers designated as Data Processors; no data will be disclosed to any third parties, even if such third parties are partners of the Data Controllers. Any disclosure of data is strictly prohibited. The complete list of designated Data Processors is available at the registered offices of the Data Controllers.

### 5. RETENTION PERIOD OF PERSONAL DATA

The determination of the retention period for personal data is based on the principle of data minimization. Your personal data will be retained for as long as you continue to access the platform. If two years pass without any access, your profile and personal data will be deleted. Regarding the sending of communications mentioned in paragraph 2(b), they will be retained for as long as you continue to agree to receive them.

### 6. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

At any time, you can request information on how your data have been acquired, verify that they are accurate, complete, up-to-date, and properly stored, and exercise the rights provided under Articles 15 et seq. of EU Regulation 2016/679 (right of access to your data, right to rectification or erasure, right to restriction of processing or to object to processing, right to data portability, right to withdraw your consent) by writing to [privacy@humanitas.it](mailto:privacy@humanitas.it) or [privacy.humanitas@pec.it](mailto:privacy.humanitas@pec.it).

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the law, you may lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority. You also have the right to appeal to the competent judicial authority.
